A Visit to Rabindra Tirtha

The place is the biggest memorial in Kolkata dedicated to the world poet. The project has been developed by the HIDCO and houses an exhibition of Tagore's paintings, archives, a research center and an auditorium. It was inaugurated in 2012. It also includes a mini cinema room, music room, Library, cafeteria and art galleries. The Department of Political Science took the initiative for students to visit Rabindra Tirtha to acquire knowledge of Political freedom and Nationalist ideas of Rabindranath Tagore.

I. Objectives:
