






Report on Educational Excursion

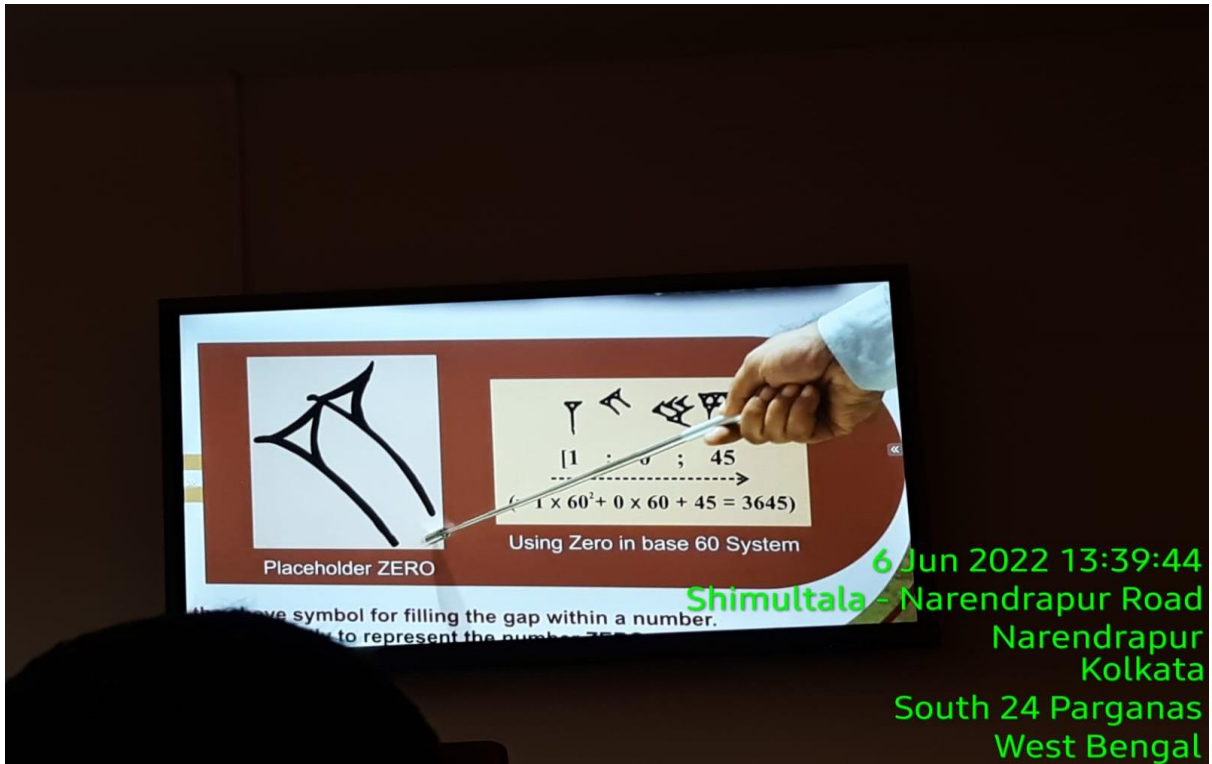
Venue: Zero Gallery, Ramakrishna Mission Residential College (Autonomous), Narendrapur, Kolkata-700103

Date: June 06, 2022

Objective: From our school days, we are familiar with the term “zero”. Zero, a seemingly simple number representing an empty quantity, has played an indispensable role in the realm of Mathematics and Science. But most of us are not fully aware of the history behind the genesis of this universally adopted notion. The “Zero Gallery” at Ramakrishna Mission Residential College, Narendrapur, Kolkata depicts the origin of zero throughout the history of several civilizations. This gallery is the result of continuous efforts of Prof. Parthasarathi Mukhopadhyay, a renowned researcher on ancient history of Mathematics, and his team. The main objective of the visit was to give the students a glimpse of the history related to this concept.

Learning Outcome: The educational tour was a wonderful learning experience for all the students as well as for all the faculty members. Before the tour inside the gallery a documentary film by Prof. Mukhopadhyay was shown, which delves into the intriguing history of the invention of zero. During the visit inside the gallery, Prof. Mukhopadhyay helps everyone to look into the pages of history behind the origin of zero. As a result, the students came to know about several civilizations and their numeral systems, for example, Egyptian Numeral System, Babylonian Numeral System, Inca Numeral System, Greek Numeral System, Roman Numeral System, Chinese Numeral System, Indian Numeral System etc. and how the history of enumeration system evolves from ancient civilization to our present day. This gives them a complete story of not only the origin zero but also the origin of the world wide used numeral system, the Hindu-Arabic Numeral System or the Indo-Arabic Numeral System.

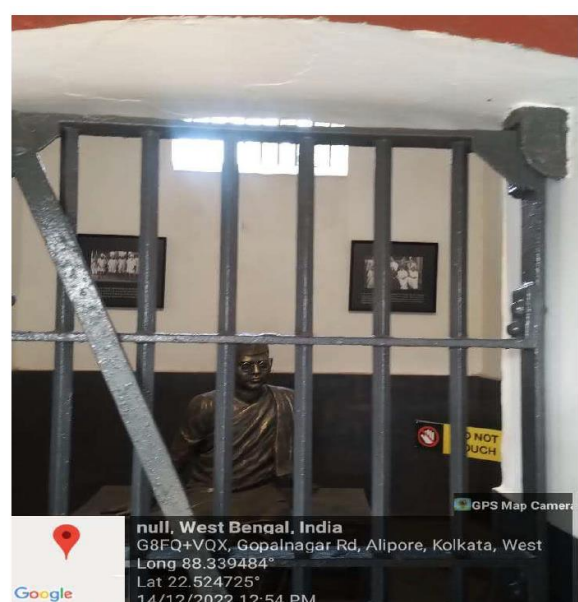
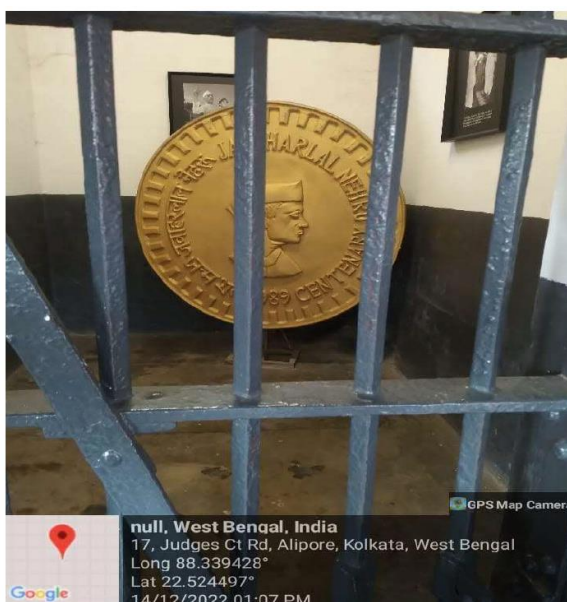


❖ Department of Political Science, Harimohan Ghose College arranged a Visit to The Alipore Museum on 14.12.2022.

During British rule, it served as a place of confinement for political prisoners who played great roles in India’s struggle for freedom. Since 23rd September 2022, the New Alipore Jail has been converted into Alipore Jail Museum, preserving and show casing this rich history for generations to come. The Department of Political Science took the initiative for students to visit Alipore Museum to gain knowledge about Political system and Culture in British Colonial Period and the sacrifices made by the freedom fighters for India’s Independence during British rule.

Objectives:

- To enlighten the students about the displayed items in the museum like coins, Gandhi Charka, etc. during British Colonial rule.
- To aware the students about curiosity, thinking skill, cruelty and torture meted to the freedom fighters by the British.
- To make the students aware of sacrifices made by the freedom fighters.

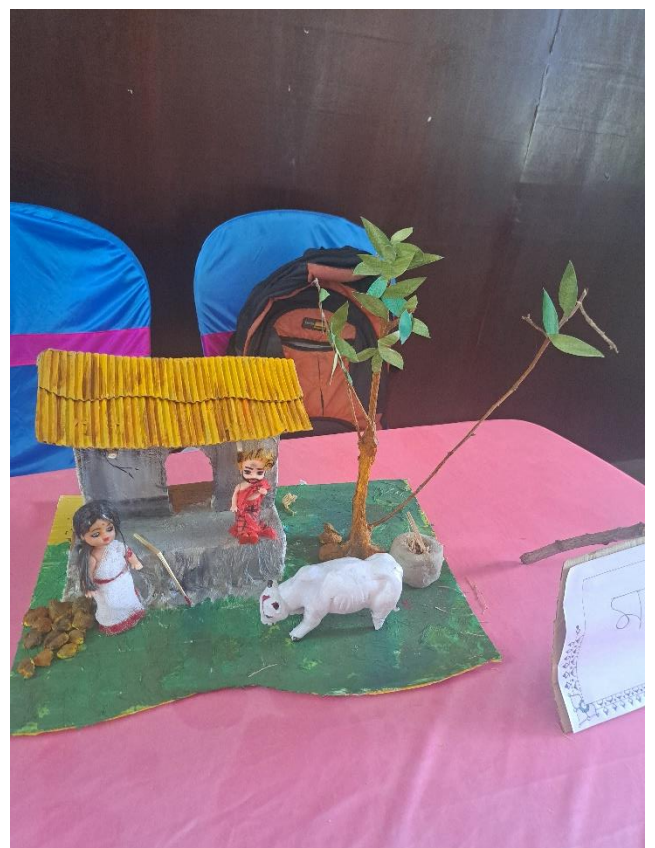

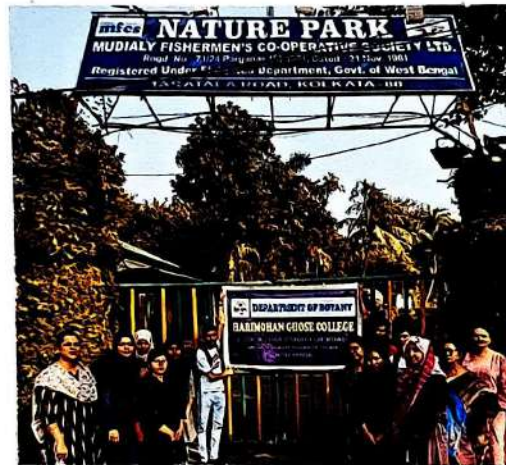
