

AND WHEREAS the First Party and the Second Party desire to enter into an agreement in which they will work together to achieve the aims and objectives relating to ONE WEEK FREE PRELIMINARY TRAINING ON CHHANA SWEET PRODOUCT MAKING at various intervals as mutually agreed between them. This is a new direction for the Youth of Bengal with job opportunities with respectable emoluments all over the country against a limited time training.

AND WHEREAS the First Party and the Second Party are desirous to enter into a MoU between them setting out the working that each of the two agree are necessary to complete the project.

**1. BACKGROUND:**

- a) The employment opportunity for the educated, trained and especially backward dropout & financially weak youth of Bengal are well-known to all.
- b) There is a dearth of trained technician all over the country.
- c) Satish Foods/IIST nurtured the idea of uplifting the needy backward, dropout youth for over a decade. The above three gave birth to a concept of making trained workforce as a social responsibility & support the Govt. in employment generation.

**2. PURPOSE & SCOPE:** The purpose of this MoU is to provide the framework, the scope of work terms and conditions and responsibilities of the Parties relating to this project as under.

- a) Framework: The training courses will run into three categories eg.
  - i) Basic - One-week free training by IIST as introduction for 2 hrs. daily for 6 days at the IIST premises and 1 day at IIST Workshop for practical / technical knowhow.
  - ii) Standard- 450 hrs. free training by IIST under Utkasha Bangla with the assistance of MSME (Karigari Bhavan) Govt. of West Bengal at IIST with workshop visit to reputed Sweet Establishment in and around the city.
  - iii) Advance - One-month hands on training after getting trained (i) &(ii) as above, against a nominal fee for making them competent Patta Karigar (Master of Making all categories of sweets with practical knowledge of end product) including workshop visits with its presentation & Sales Counter activities. This will help them, whosoever would intend to make their career as Entrepreneur in the Traditional Chhana Sweet product making.

### 3. Obligation

The obligations of the Parties will end on 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2024. In case of renewal shall be mutually agreed beforehand.


### 4. Responsibilities

- a) IIST shall provide a carry away Welcome kit containing course material, Note taking aids etc. to all intending participants at nominal Regn. Fee of Rs.100/- each for Basic & Standard Courses.
- b) Lecturers/ Practical Trainers will be made available at the Training Centre as well as Workshop.
- c) In the event the College Authority intends to conduct the weeklong Basic Session at their premises, a Transport allowances may please be considered by the Authority upon a mutually agreed norms.
- d) That the College shall provide 30 students in each batch for Basic & Standard Courses.
- e) That the College will ensure audiovisual facilities for conducting the course.

### 5. Cooperation:

The parties represent that they are amicable to draw upon to meet the objective of the project.






