- 6. Summary:

A field survey was organised with female garment manufacturing workers as subjects in the District Industrial Centre, Darjeeling, West Bengal. The experimental group of workers were young with mean age of 39.5 years. Among many cardio-respiratory parameters measured, forced vital capacity (FVC) was found to be significantly lowered (p<0.05) in the workers of the hilly region (experimental group) compared to workers of the plains. The significant change is a clear indication of impaired lung function, which may have occurred due to obstruction in the respiratory passage dure to presence of particulate matter such as cotton dust in the ambient air. Other cardio-respiratory parameters measured including BMI, heart-rate, respiratory-rate, blood glucose, peak expiratory flow rate did not alter significantly in the experimental group when compared to subject of plain areas.

In order to avoid the situation, personal protective equipment like face mask were suggested to worn by the workers in the working hours. Other precautionary measures like increased ventilation of ambient air in the workplace and environmental air filtration were also suggested to be implemented by DIC to improve worker's health and increase work-output and productivity.

- 6. Summary:

A field survey was undertaken in the Batabari tea gardens of Dooars, North Bengal with tea plucking workers as experimental subjects. A range of cardio-respiratory parameters were measured in order to assess their health status. The tea plantation workers were taken for survey due to their hazardous working conditions compared to other occupations. Among the anthropometric parameters studied, Body Mass Index (BMI) altered significantly when compared to control subjects. Lower BMI of indicated poor nutritional status and undernourishment of tea plucker population. Among cardio-respiratory parameters measured, the respiratory rate and blood pressure did not alter significantly when compared to control subjects. The survey pointed out undernourished status of female tea pluckers, which needed to be addressed by proper nutritional supplementation to increase productivity. Adequate dietary supply is required to female workers engaged in occupations like plucking of tea leaves which demands continuous physical labour. In a community, where women is the most important bread-earner of family, high prevalence of undernutrition may have adverse impact on family income and work output.
