

WeekAnti-Ragging Week, 2026

The Anti-Ragging Committee of Harimohan Ghose College in collaboration with IQAC, has adopted various measures to make our campus ragging free. This has been a continuous process since the inception of the committee in 2022. The institution has a transparent mechanism for timely redressal of student grievances regarding ragging cases. So, observation of Anti-Ragging Week is no exception to this trend.

Keeping an eye on the instructions of the University Grants Commission, dated 22nd July, 2025, posters, pamphlets and banners were hung throughout the campus in lieu of observation of Anti-Ragging Week (12-18th August, 2026). Students played a vital role in mainly the poster making.

On 18th August, 2026, a workshop was organized in order to make the students aware of ragging and its consequent punishments – “An Awareness Programme on Prevention of Ragging in College Campus”. A large number of students participated in the programme. Both teaching and Non-teaching staff were present in the programme without whom the programme would not have been successful.

This programme was a prelude to a much bigger workshop in the coming two months.
