Major Activities: National Integration Camp (NIC): The National Integration Camp (NIC) is organized every year for 7 days. It involves over 100 NSS volunteers to undertake the scheduled activities. NSS Volunteers work with Fathepur village road slums and voluntary agencies to complete 120 hours of regular activities during an academic session. 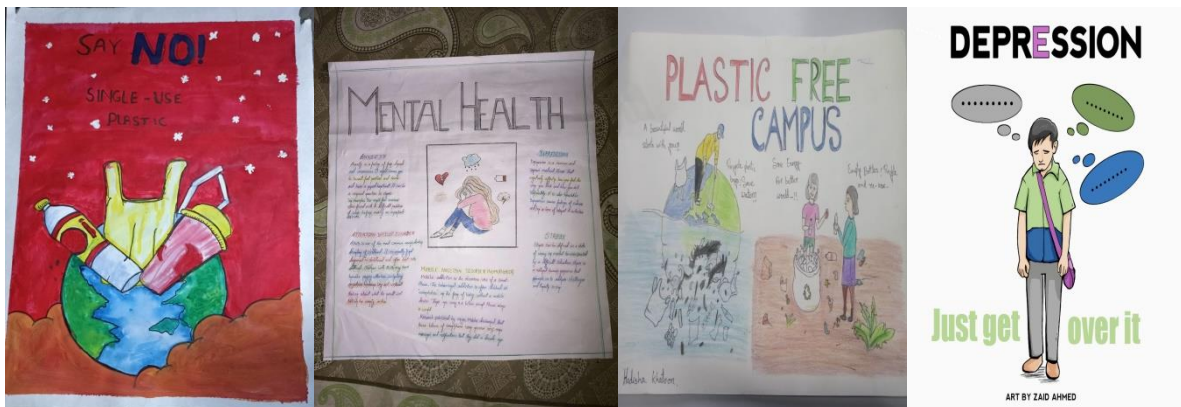
